


Isaiah 65:1 (ESV)


# Character of God - Exodus 34:6-7




# This Week – Isaiah 65:1-25

- A preserved remnant, his servants, who will inherit his land (8-10).
- Those who forsake the Lord and follow cults are destined for slaughter because he called, and they did not answer but chose what did not please him (11-12).
- Joy for the Lord's servants in the new creation. The new Jerusalem and its people (13-25).



# Our Culture Today




- 36% of U.S. adults believe the most important value to teach children is "treat others as you want to be treated"

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### Isaiah 65:17-19




<sup>17</sup> "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered or come into mind. <sup>18</sup> But be glad and rejoice forever in that which I create;

for behold, I create Jerusalem to be a joy, and her people to be a gladness. <sup>19</sup> I will rejoice in Jerusalem and be glad in my people; no more shall be heard in it the sound of weeping and the cry of distress.

- Heavens and Earth = Everything
- Former Things Everything About the Old Order Will Be Gone
- Vs 18 Emphatic...Almost a Command
- I Create Future
- The People Will Be New Too!
- The Emotion of the Old Order is Gone!
- Three New Creations
  - Believers as a New Creation (2 Cor. 5:17)
  - Millennial Kingdom (Rev. 20:4-6)
  - New Heaven and Earth (2 Pet. 3:13)



### **New Testament**



Galatians 2:20 – "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."


2 Peter 3:13 - "But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells."

Revelation 20:6 – Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years."

Revelation 21:1 – "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more."



### Isaiah 65:20-22



No more shall there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, or an old man who does not fill out his days, for the young man shall die a hundred years old, and the sinner a hundred years old shall be accursed. <sup>21</sup> They shall build houses and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit.

<sup>22</sup> They shall not build and another inhabit; they shall not plant and another eat; for like the days of a tree shall the days of my people be, and my chosen shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

- No Sinners

### Isaiah 65:23-25




<sup>23</sup> They shall not labor in vain or bear children for calamity, for they shall be the offspring of the blessed of the Lord, and their descendants with them. 24 Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear. <sup>25</sup> The wolf and the lamb shall graze together; the lion shall eat straw like the ox, and dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain," says the Lord.

  - Lion Will Eat Straw







### **Discussion Questions**



- So, after studying Isaiah 65, what's your understanding about how God basically responded to Isaiah's concerns and questions raised (in Isaiah 64:12), about God "keeping silent," and "afflicting Israel beyond measure"?
- Who is God referring to (in Isaiah 65:1) when He says He "permitted Himself to be sought by those who did not ask for Him or seek Him"?
- How might Jesus have been referring to the above in His "parable of the great supper" (in Luke 14:15-24)?
- How does God describe His "pursuits" of Israel, over time, and their response to them?
- What are some of the specific sins of the people (cited by God in verses 3-7) that "provoked" God to anger and brought His judgment on them?



### Discussion Questions p2



- Who are the "servants" (first noted in verse 8) whom God will "save"—and how does He say they will be restored and treated in contrast with those who "walk in their own ways," and "forsake the Lord for foreign deities"?
- What does this passage say about a "new heavens and a new earth," and how is this further described in the New Testament, e.g., in II Peter 3:12-13, and Revelation 21:1?
- What's your understanding of the relationship, and timeline, between the coming of "new heavens and a new earth," and the Millennial Kingdom?
- What does this passage say it will be like for the people who live in the new Jerusalem—and even for God Himself?
- What are some of the high points you gathered from Isaiah's description of Israel's future kingdom (or is it referring to the "new heavens and new earth")?
- What's something special you will take away from this lesson?
